## **Re:** Inquiry concerning the licensing status of Hahn Air Systems

I am writing to inquire about the licensing status of Hahn Air Systems in Canada, because it has come to my attention that:

- 1. Hahn Air Systems has been selling and/or has caused to be sold and/or has publicly offered for sale in Canada (and elsewhere) air services to and from Canada via CheapOair.ca; and
- 2. while Hahn Air Systems was the marketing (contracting) carrier for these air services, Sky-Greece Airlines was the operating carrier.

I have been unable to find among the Agency's online decisions any approval of code sharing between Hahn Air Systems and SkyGreece Airlines, nor any license for Hahn Air Systems to sell, cause to be sold, or publicly offer for sale air services in Canada, as it appears to be required pursuant to ss. 57-60 of the *Canada Transportation Act*, S.C. 1996, c. 10 and s. 8.2 of the *ATR*.
