
Re: Complaint by Mr. Gábor Lukács against Air Canada

Dear Sir:

We write following receipt of the Agency's Decision 204-C-A-2013 of May 27, 2012, whereby the Agency is requesting that Air Canada respond to a show cause within 30 days. As such, the delay for Air Canada to respond is June 26th, 2013.

Air Canada respectfully requests an additional 2 days (until June 28th, 2013) to respond to the Agency's decision. While the review of the questions is currently underway, given the complexity and importance of the show cause, this additional delay is necessary in order for Air Canada to finalize its response to the Agency's decision. Air Canada further notes that this extension is necessary due to the limited time available for Air Canada to finalize its answer in the coming week, considering the holiday in Quebec on Monday, June 24th, as well as the required presence of the undersigned (who has been handling the file since the beginning of the proceedings) before a tribunal throughout the day of June 26th, 2013.
