On February 26, 2016, British Airways made a request that the Agency review Decision No. 49-C-A-2016 pursuant to s. 32 of the *Canada Transportation Act*. On March 2, 2016, I made submissions in opposition of the request on the basis that, among other things, British Airways' request was vexatious, frivolous, and an abuse of process.
