Pursuant to Rule 318 of the *Federal Courts Rules*, the following is the Respondent Canadian Transportation Agency's (the "Agency") response to the Moving Party's request for material in the possession of the Agency.

1. All documents in case 15-03590.

The Agency objects to the request to produce all documents in case 15-03590.

The request lacks specificity. This is the file number that was assigned internally to the Agency's inquiry. There are numerous documents related to this file number that would have no bearing on the decision which is the subject matter of the Motion for Leave to Appeal. Documents responsive to this request include not only irrelevant documents, but documents subject to confidentiality and privilege.

The Agency is, however, producing copies of the public submissions received in the context of the public consultation. The submissions received are the public versions of these submissions. The Agency has redacted the personal information of the individuals who provided these submissions, such as personal addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses, as this information is sensitive and not relevant for the purpose of this proceeding.

2. The confidential decision dated August 21, 2015, referenced in Letter Decision No. LET-A-3-2016.

The Agency objects to producing this letter on the basis that it is confidential.

3. All correspondence sent and received by the Inquiry Officer and/or Agency staff acting on behalf of the Inquiry Officer in relation to the inquiry.

The Agency objects to producing these documents because they are confidential.

4. The Preliminary Report of the Inquiry Officer.

The Agency objects to producing this report because it contains confidential information.

5. The final report of the Inquiry Officer.

No such document exists.

6. NewLeaf's response to the Inquiry Officer

NewLeaf Travel company Inc.'s response to the Inquiry Officer dated September 4, 2016 is marked as containing confidential information. The Agency objects to producing this document because it contains confidential information.
