RE: Air Passenger Rights v. AGC and CTA (A-102-20)

Please bring this letter to Gleason J.A.'s attention on an <u>urgent</u> basis. Her Ladyship is seized of all pre-hearing issues for this case. This is regarding the Order issued today (September 2, 2022).

In the Order of September 2, 2022, the Court ordered that the Cross-examination on Ms. Cuber's affidavit be completed by September $\underline{7}$, 2022. In the parties' joint letter on August 18, 2022, we had advised the parties agreed for the cross-examination to be held on September 16, 2022 at 7AM PST / 10AM EST. The Applicant believes that the reference to September $\underline{7}$ may have been a clerical error, and the Court intended to refer to September $\underline{16}$.
