**DIRECTION**

By letter dated February 16, 2015, the applicant sought directions concerning:

- i) His ability to argue the standard of review on issues of procedural fairness is correctness (notwithstanding the concession at paragraph 26 of his memorandum of fact and law); and
- ii) The propriety of reference to an “air services agreement” by British Airways in its memorandum of fact and law.

The respondents have not replied to the applicant’s correspondence.

If any dispute arises, the panel will address any disputed issue in the course of the hearing.

The applicant shall have four copies of a supplementary book of authorities available if the panel allows fresh submissions on the standard of review.
